DEVELOPMENT OF ENTREPRENEURIAL
SYSTEM IN EASTERN EUROPE COUNTRIES

The forthcoming enlargement round is the EU biggest ever: ten new members (Malta Cyprus and 8 Phare countries) are set to join the Union in May 2004. Eastward enlargement, continuing with the joining of Romania and Bulgaria in year 2008, is the result of a gradual integration, especially in terms of economics, which took off after 1989, and opened the way for the gradual removal of trade barriers since the 1990s.

The primary aim of DESEEC Project is to contribute to further integration between EU member States and Eastern European countries, through the exchange of experience and know-how among European entrepreneurs and public bodies. Workshops and meetings between partners will help the exchange of knowhow and good practice in order to help the economic development of Phare countries.

Main thematic areas:

- Exchange of good practice, mainly relating to the opening of new markets;
- Role of public bodies in the development of enterprises on new markets;
- Collaboration among entrepreneurs from Eastern European countries and from member States;
- Development of public and private bodies.
